

How To Guide: AGING CREAM

PRO TIPS:

Aging Cream and all pigmented waxes take practice. Use of a clear wax prior to application of a pigmented wax allows for removal of pigmented wax, in cases of over application. Use a lint-free cloth with non-pigmented wax on it to erase and remove misapplication of pigmented wax. Always work on a sample board prior to first use. Different personal techniques can achieve similar results. Practice on a sample board helps you develop the personal application method that works best for your desired results.

IMPROVED FORMULA: PACKAGED IN 4 OZ. CONTAINERS

1. Aging Cream should be applied to a surface that is dry and clean. For best results, apply over a light coat of Waxing Cream.
2. CeCe Caldwell's Aging Cream can be directly applied with your finger, damp sponge, stiff brush, or damp lint-free cloth.
3. Remove any excess product with a clean, lint-free cloth.
4. Allow Aging Cream to dry. Drying time varies depending on materials, thickness of application and substrate. Generally it is dry to the touch in approximately 30–60 minutes.
5. Lightly buff after 12 hours of drying.

ORIGINAL FORMULA: PACKAGED IN HALF LITER CONTAINERS

1. Stir well before first use, mixing wax from bottom into upper layers of wax, as the pigment has a tendency to settle to the bottom of the container.
2. Apply sparingly with a soft brush to surface that has been treated with Clear Wax or Satin Finish. It becomes thin (like an oil) as you work with it.
3. Feather into areas that you want to appear aged.
4. Remove any extreme excess.

5. Leave more cream in the areas where you want the deeper pigmentation.
6. Remove all cream from areas that you do not want to have an aged appearance.
7. Allow Aging Cream to rest several minutes, before wiping away all excess.
8. Apply a second coat if needed for deeper color. The cream takes longer to dry than wax. Do not oversaturate your wood with the wax – build color slowly.
9. Use only a soft cloth to buff. Aging Cream goes on much lighter, straight from the container, than most dark waxes.
10. For a harder finish, apply a coat of Waxing Cream several days after the application of Aging Cream.
