

How To Guide: AGING DUST

PRO TIPS:

If you want to add an instant patina to a piece of furniture that does not have a lot of design interest (no carvings, turnings or embellishments), paint your piece with a heavily textured stroke. The stroke's texture will give the Aging Dust tiny crevices to settle into, adding an aged appearance.

STEPS:

1. Apply a very thin coat of CeCe Caldwell's Waxing Cream or Clear Wax to piece that has been painted or stained with CeCe Caldwell's Product.
2. Apply the wax a little heavier in nooks and crevices or on embellishments.
3. Let the wax set for 5-10 minutes.
4. Lightly cover the wax with Aging Dust.
5. With a stiff brush, press the Aging Dust into wax, covering the entire piece.
6. Allow to set for 20-30 minutes, while the Aging Dust and wax combine.
7. Gently remove excess dust.
8. Buff, concentrating on the high points, with a soft cloth using slight pressure.
