

How To Guide: GENERAL WAXING TIPS

PRO TIPS:

Apply all wax products sparingly. Use a "less is more" approach. The number one mistake made with any wax is over-applying it. With all waxes, you will achieve best results if you apply 2 light coats versus 1 heavy coat.

The best way to learn the proper technique of wax application is to remove a small portion of wax from the can and spread it onto a piece of cardboard or a paper plate. Pick up some wax with your brush or cloth and wipe the brush/cloth off on another area of the cardboard/paper plate to ensure it is evenly coated and not overloaded in a single spot on the brush/cloth. Apply to project, returning to the cardboard/paper plate to pick up additional wax. Often, you can pick up from the area on the cardboard/paper plate where you wiped off your brush/cloth. For continued shine and protection, re-apply the wax every 6-12 months under normal conditions

WAXING CREAM

STEPS:

- 1. Apply Waxing Cream with a flat-bottom (not pointed) brush or with a piece of lint-free cheesecloth.
- 2. Apply a VERY thin coat of Waxing Cream, similar to the amount that you would have on a paintbrush if you were dry brushing with paint.
- 3. SPARINGLY is the key word.
- 4. Buff it with a clean lint-free cloth/rag. Most find this thin, first coat is ALL that is needed. It shines up quickly with a light buffing. You can immediately add a second coat if needed/desired.
- 5. Waxing cream takes approximately 30 days to fully cure.



6. For continued shine and protection, re-apply the Waxing Cream every 6-12 months under normal conditions.

PRO TIPS:

Protect your finished surface from strong acids, oxidizers and grease.

Store and use between 55°-95° degrees F.

ADVANTAGES:

Uses less wax to achieve better results (more economical).

Less effort (buffing) needed to get higher shine.

Waxing Cream provides deeper penetration of wax into the paint.

CLEAR WAX

STEPS:

- 1. Clear Wax should be applied in a thin, even coat with a flat-bottom brush or lint-free cloth.
- 2. Apply sparingly. Always use less wax than you think is needed. It is best to apply several thin layers than one heavy layer.
- 3. Wipe away excess. The surface should then be thoroughly buffed with a dry cloth, piece of brown kraft paper, or finishing pad after 2-4 hours.
- 4. For an even harder finish, the wax can be rebuffed 2-4 days after the initial buffing. This product requires several weeks to fully cure.
- 5. Freshly waxed surfaces should be kept free of moisture and heavy use for about a week. For continued shine and protection, re-apply the Clear Wax every 6-12 months under normal conditions.
